

DAY 1: FRIDAY, 15 AUGUST 2025 JOHANNESBURG - ISTANBUL |

EXCITEMENT BUILDS FOR DEPARTURE.

 Our journey begins as we meet at the Turkish Airlines check-in counters at O.R. Tambo International Airport, ready to embark on our adventure to Istanbul and beyond.

DAY 2: SATURDAY, 16 AUGUST 2025 ISTANBUL - KAYSERI - CAPPADOCIA |

ARRIVE, EXPLORE CAVES, AND ENJOY DINNER.

- We arrive in Istanbul early in the morning, clear customs, and meet our tour guide before boarding a domestic flight to Nevşehir, the capital of the Cappadocia region.
- As we travel through this breathtaking region of surreal rock formations, we discover an ancient underground city that once housed early Christians.
- The day concludes with a delicious dinner at our hotel.

DAY 3: SUNDAY, 17 AUGUST 2025 CAPPADOCIA | SOAR OVER CAPPADOCIA, EXPLORE VALLEYS, AND DISCOVER HISTORY.

- Some may begin their day with an optional, unforgettable hot air balloon safari over Cappadocia's otherworldly landscapes.
- We then visit the Göreme Valley, which features "fairy chimney" rock formations and ancient rock-hewn churches adorned with vibrant frescoes of Christ and early Christian saints such as St. Basil and St. George.
- Our journey continues through the villages of Avanos, Zelve, and Uchisar, with stops at scenic valleys and an underground city once sheltering thousands.
- Cappadocia's rich artistic heritage comes to life as we visit a pottery cave, where
 generations have crafted ceramics, and a carpet weaving centre showcasing exquisite
 handmade kilims.

DAY 4: MONDAY, 18 AUGUST 2025 CAPPADOCIA - KONYA - PAMMUKALE |

SILK ROAD STOPS, ANCIENT RUINS, THERMAL RELAXATION.

- We journey to Pamukkale via Konya, stopping at the well-preserved Sultanhani Caravanserai, once a key stop along the Silk Road.
- As we travel through Turkey's agricultural heartland, we reflect on the journeys of Apostle Paul and Barnabas before crossing a breathtaking mountain range and visiting the petrified waterfall, one of the world's natural wonders.
- In Pamukkale, we see the famous "cotton castle" terraces and visit the ancient city of Hierapolis, which was founded in the second century BC.
- A visit to a cotton factory offers a chance to shop for quality textiles, and in the evening, we unwind in the soothing thermal baths.

DAY 5: TUESDAY, 19 AUGUST 2025 PAMUKKALE - EPHESUS - KUSADASI | TRACING THE FOOTSTEPS OF EARLY CHURCHES.

- We start the day by exploring the 7 churches, beginning with Laodicea, founded around 260 BC and home to a major ecumenical council in the 4th century.
- Next, we visit Philadelphia, the "City of Brotherly Love," founded by King Attalus II, and Sardis, the ancient capital of Lydia, where we reflect on the significance of its restored gymnasium and synagogue.
- Our journey ends in Selçuk, near the ancient city of Ephesus on the Aegean coast.

DAY 6: WEDNESDAY, 20 AUGUST 2025 KUSADASI - EPHESUS - KUSADASI |


EPHESUS UNVEILED: HISTORY & LEGACY.


- Today is the highlight of our tour! We visit the ancient city of Ephesus, one of the bestpreserved ancient cities and a site of the Seven Churches of the Apocalypse.
- We visit the House of the Virgin Mary and the 6th-century Basilica of St. John, where St. John is buried.
- We visit the Virgin Mary's House, a peaceful hillside sanctuary where she is thought to have spent her final years. The Vatican recognises it as a pilgrimage site, attracting visitors seeking reflection and a connection to history.
- We also explore a local leather factory, renowned for its craftsmanship.

DAY 7: THURSDAY, 21 AUGUST 2025 KUSADASI | PERGAMUM'S HISTORY AND SMYRNA'S MARKET.

- After breakfast, we head to Smyrna (Izmir), another of the Seven Churches. It is the
 third biggest city in Turkey, with an important harbour and trade centre for the export
 of tobacco, grapes, olives, and the wonderful, well-known figs of Smyrna.
- We visit the ancient agora, the only excavated area of the Smyrna.
- We return to the hotel and have the afternoon at leisure!

DAY 8: FRIDAY, 22 AUGUST 2025 KUSADASI - PERGAMUM - BURSA |

- After breakfast, we drive to Pergamum, which was once the capital of a powerful kingdom. We explore the Acropolis, home to one of the largest libraries in the ancient world.
- We then depart for Bursa to overnight.

- After crossing the scenic Sea of Marmara by ferry boat, we arrive in Istanbul by late afternoon
- The rest of the day is yours to relax and explore before enjoying a delicious dinner at the hotel.

EXPLORE MARKETS AND SHOP AT GRAND BAZAAR.


- Begin exploring the city with an option to visit local markets.

EXPLORE ISTANBUL'S LANDMARKS, BOSPORUS CRUISE.


- Start the day with a classical tour of Istanbul, visiting the old town and Hippodrome Square
